Thank you for choosing Parkview for your healthcare needs. As you approach discharge from the hospital, your physician may prescribe medication to help in your continued healing. At Parkview, we make it convenient for you to fill your prescription medication before you even leave the hospital.

Our Meds to Beds program, offered by the Parkview Pharmacy, is a convenient service that makes filling your prescriptions easy and effortless.

What is Meds to Beds?

The Parkview Pharmacy, located on the Parkview Regional Medical Center campus, works with your care team to fill your prescription medications and then delivers them directly to your bedside before discharge.

How long does it take for my prescriptions to be delivered?

Our Meds to Beds program will not delay your discharge. Once your care team orders your prescription, Parkview Pharmacy team members will then process your order as if you were standing in line right there in the pharmacy! Once your order is processed, a dedicated member of the Pharmacy team will deliver your medication directly to your room.



How will I pay for my prescription medications?

Similar to if you were checking out in person at the pharmacy, you will receive a bill at the time your prescription medication is delivered. The expense is run through your insurance, and then you will be asked to pay the remaining balance by credit card or personal check*. Most major insurance is accepted.

* Personal check is accepted if the expense is less than \$100.

What if I have a question for the pharmacist?

Upon delivery, a Parkview pharmacy technician will have a designated phone for you to speak directly to a pharmacist should you have any questions regarding your medications.

Will I have to pay more for this service?

There is no added expense for the service of having your prescription delivered to your room. We want to make your transition out of the hospital as smooth as possible. Our Meds to Beds program offers you the same service as any other stand-alone pharmacy that you use in the community. In fact, as a not-for-profit, Parkview Pharmacy can often offer medication at a lower cost.

Note: Please keep in mind if your insurance company prefers you use a specific pharmacy.
